

Minutes for the Christian Fellowship BOF business meeting, March 24, 2005

Fifty-five people attended the meeting. Florence Archibald led with prayer and the meeting was opened at 4:05 PM by the Treasurer, Barbara Henderson. She announced that Gordon Kuntz was unable to be in attendance of this meeting but will continue to serve as President. Norman Hamlow will not be able to continue his duties as Vice President, leaving this position open. Barbara Henderson will continue on as Treasurer. It was also pointed out that the Newsletter Editor position is open.

There were no minutes available to be read from the previous year. The Treasurer's report was read. It was announced that \$665 had been received for membership dues and \$21 had been donated to the chapter, designated for C.A.R.E. Moved by Orv Schinke that the Treasurer's report be accepted as read. All in favor.

Roger Starkey, a retired school teacher and retired preacher offered to fill the position of Vice President and Jeannie Tyhurst volunteered for the Secretary position. Both were nominated and voted in by acclamation. There was no opposition.

### Old Business

The following items were brought before the group.

1. The idea of having a pre or post rally could be set up if there was enough interest.
2. Patches or decals are the only things the BOF may sell on Chapter Row during an Escapade.
3. The old BOF logo for Christian Fellowship has been replaced with a new one which includes a picture of a church with a cross on the roof. It was suggested that the Christian Fellowship badges with the old logo be replaced with the new one.

Barbara mentioned that a way for the Christian Fellowship BOF to get credit for estate donations to C.A.R.E. should be made to the BOF for distribution to C.A.R.E.

Florence Archibald has collected \$235 to date for 05-06 dues. The dues are used for newsletter, postage, and other expenses. We have a balance of \$1383.84 as of this meeting before Row expenses are paid.

The Fall Escapade in DuQuoin, IL will be held September 25-30. Judy Baird volunteered to be our Row Representative. Dale and Florence Archibald have volunteered again to be our representative for the Spring '06 Escapade in Chico, CA. April 23-28th.

Dale Archibald announced that we would be taking an offering for C.A.R.E. tonight at the Fellowship Dinner at HomeTown Buffet, 5:30 pm in Calexico. He suggested that if anyone needed a ride to the dinner, they ask the person sitting next to them. He then closed in prayer and the meeting was adjourned at 4:50 PM.
