

CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP BOF BUSINESS MEETING, 4/10/2003
MINUTES

The meeting opened at 4:05 with prayer by Richard Chapman. Sharon Cook was acting secretary. Officers present: Richard Chapman, Barbara Henderson, Sharon Cook, Marge Schinke.

18 SKP numbers were represented to form a quorum. The minutes of the 2002 business meeting were read; motion to approve by John Ray, seconded by Ann Luxford, approved.

The new officers' slate for 2003-2004 was presented: President, Gordon Kuntz; Vice-president, Norman Hamlow; Secretary, Ruth Wallestad; Treasurer, Barbara Henderson; Membership, Richard Chapman; Editor, Sharon Cook; Webmaster, Marge Schinke. Allen Keil motioned, Ann Luxford seconded to split the editor/membership job into two separate jobs, motion passed. No new officers were presented from the floor. Ann Luxford motioned, John Ray seconded, and motion passed to approve officers' slate.

Fellowship Get-togethers can be held at SKP parks as part of the Christian Fellowship BoF. Two parks, Jobba Hills and Benson, have already requested to do this. The only requirement is that one of the leaders of the group be an official BoF member. This will allow the meetings to be in the Escapee magazine, on the website, and in the newsletter. Groups deciding to hold meetings should inform one of the officers so these announcements can be made. Eva Sprague motioned and a second was made, the vote was passed to approve this.

A reminder was made that dues are now due for 2003-2004. We are required to have 150 members to remain certified. Over 60 have already renewed their dues this week. Ginger Chapman motioned, Andrea Hamlow seconded to allow members to pay more than three years in advance if they desire. Motion passed.

The treasurer's report was presented by Barbara Henderson. Current balance as of April 1st is \$838.03, with primary expenses being Chapter Row representatives and newsletter.

Announcements: thanks to the helpers on Chapter Row; Fun Days and Fall Escapade Chapter Row representatives needed; we need e-mails to be kept current for easier contact (we will investigate an easier method of keeping in touch through some central mailbox system—there is also voicemail on the Escapee system.)

The new logo was presented. Ginger Chapman motioned, John Ray seconded to approve the logo. A discussion resulted in Don Thomas making a motion with Sam Scherf seconding to straighten the cross on top of the church. The amendment passed and the logo, as amended, was approved. The banner will be revised to reflect the change.

A request was made for a nomination committee chairperson for next year, but there were no volunteers.

Jim Cook made the motion to adjourn, Steve O'Boskey seconded, motion passed.
