President's Corner

WHERE TO WE GO FROM HERE?

During 2007 we as members of Christian Fellowship enjoyed a very fine and active year as we had two really good Escapades and a number of really enjoyable Gatherings. As your President I've been pleased to be involved in a Fellowship that has shown a desire for getting together and for helping others—both through CARE and two Christian missions. So my question is Where do we go from here? We are facing new challenges.



Let's start with Scripture - Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might. Ecclesiastes 9:10.

As we proceed into this New Year I think our Christian Fellowship BOF has good goals. Let us examine some of them as we want to be seen as an authentic, effective, content and caring group within the Escapees RV Club. As individuals within the Fellowship let's look at some steps: First, allow what is good and encouraging to penetrate your spirit as deeply as possible. For some reason it takes a dozen encouragements to balance a single negative encounter. Our past successes we had yesterday still haven't overcome the single failure of last week. A good plan might be to start each morning with a prayer of gratitude for the events and relationships that await us and to fall asleep at night with thoughts of thankfulness—rather than self-criticism—for what has been. We move toward that upon which we dwell, so let those positive moments come often into focus. Give thanks with all your might.

Second, let satisfaction be a reward you accept without guilt. Sometimes, because of messages received in childhood, we imagine that if we feel good we are somehow displeasing God. But it is actions, not feelings, which please or displease Him. The Scottish athlete Eric Liddell {Chariots of Fire} told his sister who wanted him to give up his running in order to be a missionary, "God made me fast. And when I run, I feel His pleasure." Ask yourself what makes you sense God's pleasure. Identify that and do it with all your might.

Third, make forgiveness your primary response to those who wound you. A friend told me of a massage therapist who can discern with his fingers which leg a patient usually crosses over the other while sitting. The continuing effect of tension in the muscles gives it away. So also do our bodies and souls store up unresolved tension when we carry resentments with us through the day. They keep us from full health and real contentment. Let them go. When I get a dent in my car I have it pounded out and repainted. For heaven's sake, why would I not do the same for my heart? Forgive and forget with all your might.

So, what's your goal? What steps are needed to get there? What will be your first step, and when will you take it?

As I previously mentioned, let us in our Christian Fellowship BOF go forward in 2008 to fellowship and serve at God's pleasure wherever and however we can. May God bless you is my prayer.


Thank you for your kind donation of \$150. We shall send the cheque to our bank for the exchange transaction.

Membership Expiration

At the annual business meeting during the Spring Escapade in Chico, CA in April 2006, a discussion was held concerning moving the dues paying dates to the end of each year through which members paid. Accordingly, those members whose dues were paid to April 2006 were given a grace period whereby their dues did not expire until December 31, 2006. Awaiting Surgery

At the time of publishing this newsletter, I am patiently awaiting surgery on my back to correct a couple of degenerative discs and remove obstructions that are causing nerves to be pinched. The pain in my back and leg has been building for the past couple of years and is now to the point where it is so excruciating that it has to be fixed. We're standing on the promises of God that include "by Jesus' stripes I'm healed."

I've been through all the tests: MRI, CT Scan, Nuclear CT Scan and x-rays as well as an EMG which is a nerve test to confirm to the surgeon that his diagnosis is correct. I'll be in a back brace for three months and in some type of rehabilitation for up to a year which will include exercises such as stretching, building up leg muscles, back muscles, etc.
