Yehoshua/Joshua

Oh, sure, Joshua “fit the battle of Jericho...and the walls came tumblin’ down”, but he also did some of the same things Moshe/Moses did.

Moshe led the Yisraelites across the divided Yam Suf/Red Sea, or Sea of Reeds, and Yehoshua led the people across the Yarden/Jordan River as it split. Also, just as Joshua and Caleb were two of the 12 spies sent by Moshe to spy out the land, so Joshua sent two spies to reconnoiter the Jericho region. They met, and were saved by, the woman, Rahab, who was destined to become the great grandmother/ancestor of Yeshua/Jesus. Rahab lied to the soldiers and hid the spies because she knew that the Lord had given the country to the Yisraelites, and had favored them in many battles.

That the Yisraelites seems to have been favored by their God, led all the kings west of the Yarden to attempt to enter a pact with them thru the disguise of old and worn-out clothing, sandals, wineskins, and stale bread. After giving his word, Joshua learned that they had deceived him, but he kept his word and they became the wood hewers and water drawers for the Yisraelites.

It was Joshua who set up an altar on Mount Ebal, and who set half the people to face Mount Ebal and the other half to face Mount Gerizim, and he read all the words of the blessings and the curses, every word that Moshe had commanded.

Joshua apportioned the land to the 12 tribes. Reuben, Gad, and Menasse remained in the land to the east of the Yarden, but they set up their families there and then went forward to cross the Yarden and help their brothers as they conquered the tribal lands west of the Yarden. Menasse and Ephraim were named as tribes, (both sons of Yosef, thereby giving Yosef the double portion due to the first-born...remember Yosef was the first born of Ya’akov/Jacob and Rachel) but the effect is that one replaced Yosef, and one replaced Levi, because the Levites had no tribal lands, but they were awarded 48 towns of sanctuary.

The bones of Yosef were brought from Egypt, and buried at Shechem, and Yehoshua died at the age of 110 years.

The book of Joshua transitions from the wilderness to the conquering of, and the settlement of, the land of Yisrael. It is a book of war stories and strategy which any young boy would love to read.

But, it is a deeply prophetic book, too. A comparison between Joshua and Revelation would include such similarities as:

(1) The name, Yehoshua/Joshua, and Yeshua/Jesus are basically the same name, meaning Salvation, or God saves, or God is Salvation, or God’s Salvation.

(2) Joshua’s purpose was to lead God’s people into the promised land, and “evict” the pagans there, and in

Revelation the purpose at that time is to “evict” the pagans on earth, and lead God’s people into the New Jerusalem.

(3) Joshua sends two witnesses, called spies, into Jericho; there are two witnesses in Revelation.

(4) The attack on Jericho was prefaced by 6 days of silence while they marched around the walls, and then, at the blast of a trumpet, the events unfolded (the walls “unfolded”, too!) In Revelation the 7 trumpets come after a period of silence.

Romans 8:34-37

God does not want us to be anything less than champions. God never calls any of us to be quitters or losers. He calls us to be winners and conquerors through Jesus Christ.

But becoming a real champion requires discipline—for true champions are made, not born.

Many lessons must be learned if we are going to be champions. One crucial lesson is that we must surround ourselves with those who will challenge us to do our best.

David surrounded himself with 30 mighty men who had outstanding abilities and talents. These men dedicated themselves to their task and to David. They fought for David, and some gave their lives in battle.

Three of the men fought just to get their commander a drink of water. With his friend’s help, David became an effective military conqueror and a great king. He became a champion by surrounding himself with champions.

Jesus our Lord did not begin His ministry with several thousand followers. He selected 12 men who became champions. One later defaulted, but the 11 who remained later turned the world upside down.

The Apostle Paul surrounded himself with champions. One was Barnabas, who accompanied Paul on his first missionary journey.

Another was Titus, who had a specialized ministry of nurturing and building up the local churches Paul had planted.
